If authorized by the court, pursuant to Penal Code Sections 1202.4(n), 1205.3, or other applicable statute, court fees and fines may be converted to community service hours at a rate of \$10.00 per hour.

Pursuant to California Rules of Court, rule 10.603(d), the clerk of the court and the Mendocino County Collections Department is delegated authority to convert fines to community service in the following manner:

1. FELONY/MISDEMEANORS
 - a. If a fine or fee is owed and probation has since expired or terminated, the clerk may do a one-time conversion of the balance to community service upon request.
 - b. If a fine or fee is owed and probation was never imposed, the clerk may do a one-time conversion of the balance to community service upon request.
2. INFRACTION CASES
 - a. If a fine or fee is owed on an adjudicated case, the clerk may do a one-time conversion of the total or balance to community service upon request.

Restitution ordered pursuant to Penal Code Sections §§ 1202.4, 1202.44 and 1202.45 shall not be converted to community service hours.

This standing order shall expire on **December 31, 2017**.
