**STANDING ORDER: 2025-05**


In any civil action where a *Notice of Settlement of Entire Action* has been filed indicating that an unconditional or conditional settlement has been reached, and in which the filing party fails to file a dismissal, enter judgment, or request reinstatement of the case, an Order to Show Cause hearing shall be set and noticed.

Parties and/or counsel shall be required to appear at the Order to Cause hearing to show cause as to why sanctions should not be imposed to failure to dismiss, enter judgment, or request reinstatement of the action.

Upon filing of a dismissal of the action or a request for judgment or reinstatement of the action, the Order to Show Cause hearing shall be vacated, and the appearance of parties and/or counsel will not be required.

This standing order shall expire on July 1, 2025.
